Removes and installs engines, props or rotor blades, transmissions, flight controls and other aircraft components.

Read and interpret original equipment manufacturer and program maintenance manuals, service bulletins, and other related documentation to determine feasibility and method of altering or repairing the aircraft and its associated components.

Determines the airworthiness of the aircraft and its associated components.

Troubleshoots, repairs, and replaces electrical wiring and associated components.

Performs miscellaneous duties to service aircraft, including hydraulic system servicing, engine oil replenishment, aircraft systems lubrication, aircraft fueling, etc.

Interacts with Company maintenance control, the customer and manufacturer in matters that concern the airworthiness of the aircraft, operational readiness of the aircraft and issues related to the troubleshooting of the aircrafts system.
